La Vance Coleman, a former addict who battled crack cocaine and alcoholism for years, has been sober since June 2004. Now, he is devoted to helping other men struggling with addictions, and on January 2, 2012, he opened the Remnant House.

The name "Remnant" signifies the small remaining piece of a person's soul, as described in Luke 13:6-9, offering one more chance at redemption. La Vance firmly believes in the power of Christ to restore men to their true potential and aims to provide that opportunity to those willing to change their life's story. The Remnant House represents the first step toward reclaiming the life God has planned for them.

La Vance Coleman traveled down the road of addiction, battling the clutches of crack cocaine and alcoholism for many years. La Vance has been sober now since June 2004 and has committed himself to help other men who are struggling and are held in bondage by addictions.

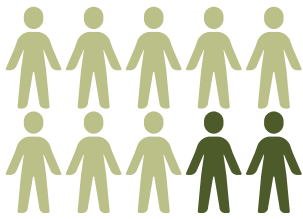

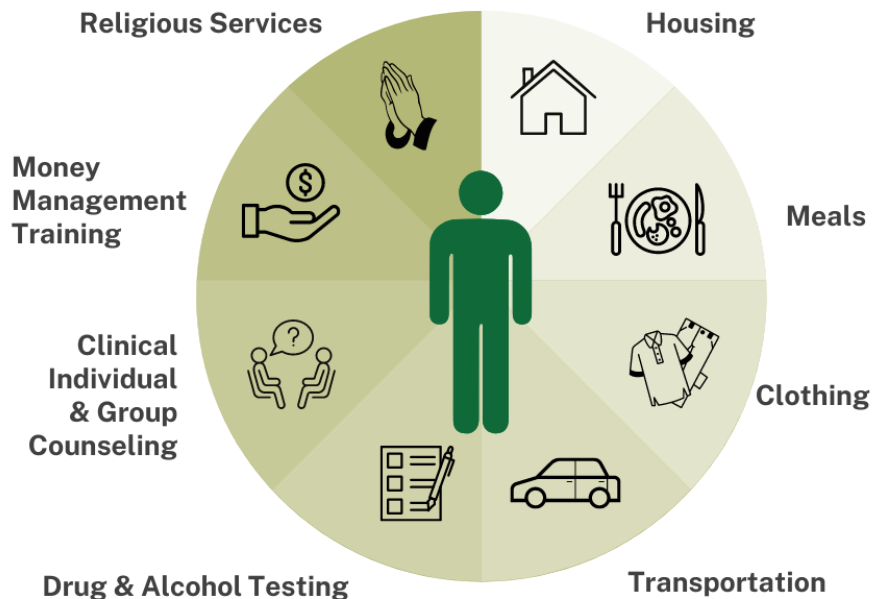

Transportation

In our 24/7/365 opioid treatment and recovery program, adequate transportation stands as one of the two most critical resources. We provide transportation to the following locations:

- NA meetings and other addiction therapy
- Job placement training, interviews, and work sites
- All medical/dental appointments
- Hospital or detoxification drop-off or pick-up
- Educational and community service opportunities
- Court, probation, and parole hearings
- Community and fellowship functions



Housing

Housing is our most crucial resource and the most significant cost in our fight against addiction. Providing on-site housing for the men in our program provide:

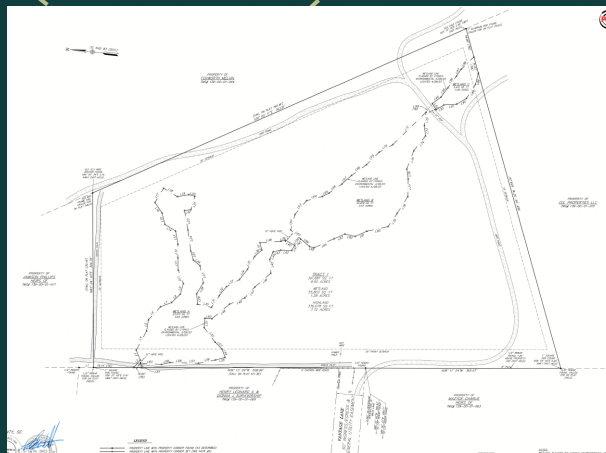
Clear The Land

Move In

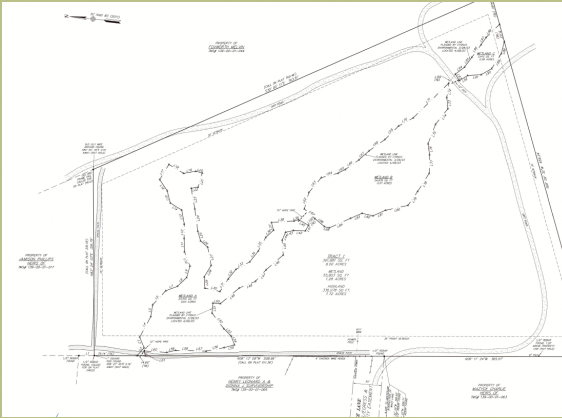
We'll move our men into their new recovery community and continue to fundraise to expand the number of homes, and men, we'll be able to provide services to.
